- A coordinated approach with the Security Regulator and other relevant organisations.
- Use of intelligence sources and networking to maintain an accurate assessment of risk.

Maintain a strong security culture.

- Implementation of security awareness training and regular security briefs.
- Encouraging the reporting of security concerns and events.

Maintain arrangements in compliance with all legal and regulatory requirements.

- Operating effective security management systems in accordance with the NSSP.
- Efficient inspection, testing and maintenance of security systems.
- Continuous development of the LLWR Security Team and Wider Organisation
- Effective reporting and investigating events.
