





#### Q5 The definitions of marine casualties and marine incidents are clear





## Q6 I understand the obligation to report marine casualties and marine incidents





#### Q7 It is easy to report a marine casualty or marine incident to The MAIB





## Q8 The time and effort expended in reporting a marine casualty or marine incident is reasonable







## Q12 The 30-day consultation period for reports in advance of publication is adequate





### Q13 The MAIB policy not to name individuals in its reports is correct







## Q16 MAIB recommendations are proportionate to the size of the organisation they are made to




