Thank you for your email of 18 January 2013 where you requested the following information:

I would like to request a list of all staff who have been seconded from outside organisations and are working on nuclear energy issues. For each person, I would like to request their:

- name
- job title
- the department they work in
- the company/organisation they have been seconded from (i.e. their employer)
- a brief iob description
- the start and end dates of the secondment
- the amount the department is paying for them

I would like to limit my request from 1 January 2010 to the present day.

### Freedom of Information Act 2000

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'). Under the Act you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you have requested and;
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

#### People working on nuclear energy issues

There are 5 staff who are currently seconded to DECC from outside organisations who are working on nuclear energy issues. The details that you have requested for these people are set out at Annex A.

The records for those who have been seconded to DECC from outside organisations since 1 January 2010 and who have since left DECC are not held centrally. We are seeking to gather this information from individual policy areas but this is taking longer than expected and is not included in this response. We will provide you with an update on this information as soon as possible.

## Appeals procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to the Security & Information Rights Unit (foi@decc.gsi.gov.uk).
