### The NHS Business Services Authority (Awdurdod Gwasanaethau Busnes y Gig) Amendment Directions 2011

The Secretary of State for Health gives the following directions in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 8, 272(7) and (8) and 273(1) and (4) of the National Health Service Act 2006(a).

#### **Citation, commencement and application**

1.—(1) These Directions may be cited as the NHS Business Services Authority (Awdurdod Gwasanaethau Busnes y Gig) Amendment Directions 2011.

(2) These Directions come into force on 1st April 2011.

(3) These Directions apply to the NHS Business Services Authority (Awdurdod Gwasanaethau Busnes y Gig) established by the NHS Business Services Authority (Awdurdod Gwasanaethau Busnes y Gig) (Establishment and Constitution) Order 2005(b).

#### **Amendment to direction 2 of the NHS Business Services Authority (Awdurdod Gwasanaethau Busnes y Gig) Directions 2006**

2. In direction 2 (establishment of a Counter Fraud and Security Management Service Division) of the NHS Business Services Authority (Awdurdod Gwasanaethau Busnes y Gig) Directions 2006(c) number the existing text as paragraph (1) and at the end add—

“(2) That division may also be known as “NHS Protect”.”.
