# The Primary Medical Services (Electronic Prescription Service Authorisation) (Amendment) Directions 2011

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 8 and 273(1) of the National Health Service Act 2006(a), gives the following Directions.

### Citation, commencement and application

- 1.—(1) These Directions may be cited as the Primary Medical Services (Electronic Prescription Service Authorisation) (Amendment) Directions 2011 and come into force on 1st February 2011.
  - (2) These Directions apply in relation to England.
