5. ESA – Work Related Assessment Group (WRAG) referrals are classified as referrals to the following customer groups; ESA (c) WRAG Mandatory, ESA (c) WRAG Voluntary, ESA (IR) WRAG 12Mth Mandatory, ESA (IR) WRAG 12Mth Voluntary, ESA (IR) WRAG 3/6Mth Stock, ESA (IR) WRAG 3/6 Mth

Mandatory, ESA (IR) WRAG 3/6 Mth Voluntary, ESA (IR) WRAG 3/6 Mth Mandatory ExIB and ESA (IR) WRAG 3/6 Mth Voluntary ExIB.

6. ESA – Support Group referrals are classified as referrals to the following customer groups; ESA (IR) Support Group, ESA (c) Support Group, ESA (IR) Support Group ExIB and ESA (c) Support Group ExIB.

To find the number of referrals by financial quarter and benefit claimed / participation on employment programme four weeks prior to programme referral, scroll down and select **Work Choice: Official Statistics – August 2012**, the information is available in table 5 on page 17 of the publication.

For example, to produce statistics on the number of Work Programme attachments with a disability or health condition, from the earliest to latest date available, go to <http://research.dwp.gov.uk/asd/index.php?page=tabtool> scroll down and select “**Click here for statistics regarding the Work Programme**” in the **Employment Programmes** section, then under **Benefit/Scheme**, select **Work Programme: Cumulative figures**. For the first drop down menu, next to **Analysis**, select **Attachments (Thousands)** and then under **Row**, select **Payment Group**. Then under **Column** select either **Disability Indicator** or **Primary Health Condition**. Then continue to make relevant table selections from there using **July 2012** in the **Date** option which is the latest data available. Once you have selected all of the above select **Get Table**.
