## FOREWORD

1. These accounts are prepared under section 21(1) of the National Loans Act 1968. They follow the pattern established by previous accounts and include figures for the previous year.

2. Part I covers the transactions on the Consolidated Fund in the year ended 31 March 1984 including revenue from taxation and miscellaneous receipts, issues for Supply Services and for those services which, under various Acts of Parliament, are charged directly on the Consolidated Fund. This account also shows the deficit over the year as a whole, which was met from the National Loans Fund under section 18(3) of the 1968 Act.

3. Part II gives details of the receipts and payments of the National Loans Fund in the same period, including the payment to meet the Consolidated Fund deficit referred to in the previous paragraph, issues of sterling capital to and repayments from, the Exchange Equalisation Account, and all transactions in respect of the principal and the service of the National Debt. Details are also given of the issues to Ministers for the purpose of making loans to nationalised industries, local authorities and other borrowers, and of the amounts received in respect of interest on the repayments of such loans. Most of the departmental accounts which record these loan transactions will be published later in a separate volume "Accounts relating to issues from the National Loans Fund 1983-84".

4. Further information about the transactions, assets and liabilities of both Funds appears in the Supplementary Statements prepared by the Treasury in accordance with section 21(3) of the 1968 Act (House of Commons Paper No 91 of 1984-85).

5. The present accounts show that there was a deficit on the Consolidated Fund in 1983-84 of £9,087 million; loans from the National Loans Fund, less repayments, amounted to £3,413 million; net repayments by the Exchange Equalisation Account were £600 million; payments of £188 million and £1,323 million were made to the International Monetary Fund to maintain the value of its holding of sterling and as an additional subscription respectively; and the National Debt Commissioners made payments totalling £47 million to reduce their liability in respect of the National Savings Bank Investment Fund. After taking account of net borrowing by the National Loans Fund in 1983-84 of £13,373 million, these transactions resulted in a balance on the Fund, at 31 March 1984, of £8 million.

### *Finance Act 1983*

6. The Finance Act 1983 included provision (in section 45) for the Treasury, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State, to suspend, by means of a Statutory Instrument, payments due on any new town development loan, subject to the aggregate value of loans involved not exceeding £1,250 million. Any such suspension starts on the date of coming into force of an Order and runs until 30 September 1986.

7. The effect is that all payments of interest and principal remaining outstanding on a loan when a suspension Order comes into force will be postponed by the interval between the effective date of the Order and 1 October 1986. No interest will accrue for the period of the suspension.

8. For the purpose of section 45 "new town development loans" means any sum falling within section 60(a) of the New Towns Act 1981 or borrowed by the Development Board for Rural Wales under section 9(2)(a) of the Development of Rural Wales Act 1976.

9. Under the New Towns (Suspension of Loan Repayments) Order 1983 (S.I. 1983 No. 1377), which came into operation on 12 September 1983, payments due on loans to an aggregate value of £1,186,100,000 were suspended.

*Miscellaneous Financial Provisions Act 1983*

10. Section 6 of the Miscellaneous Financial Provisions Act 1983 gave the Treasury power, upon written notice to the beneficiary, to redeem certain annuities, payable out of the Consolidated Fund, not exceeding £2,000 a year and payable since the passing of the Consolidated Fund (Permanent Charges Redemption) Act 1873. The 1983 Act determined the redemption payment to be made as a sum that would be needed to purchase an amount of undated government stock yielding annual dividends equal to the amount of the annuity. The Act also provided that any redemption payments were to be paid out of the Consolidated Fund.

11. During 1983-84 17 annuities amounting to £24,109.74 a year were redeemed by payments totalling £249,731.38.

*Commonwealth Development Corporation Acts 1978 and 1982*

12. Section 1 of the Commonwealth Development Corporation Act 1982 extended the Corporation's borrowing powers under the 1978 Act by providing, for the first time, for the Corporation to borrow sums from the Secretary of State out of the National Loans Fund.

13. The first issue from the National Loans Fund under the Acts was made during 1983-84.
