Foreword

Machinery of Government changes

During this reporting period a number of machinery of government changes occurred. These have not been reflected within the document but details of the changes have been provided.

29th March 2007

Some responsibilities from the Home Office were transferred to the Department for Constitutional Affairs, resulting in the formation a new department, the Ministry of Justice.

28th June 2007

The responsibilities of Department of Trade Industry and the Department for Education and Skills were split resulting in the formation of three new departments, the Department for Business, Enterprise and Regulatory Reform, the Department for Innovation, Universities and Skills and the Department for Children, Schools and Families.

Responsibility for equality were transferred from the Department for Work and Pensions to a new department, the Government Equality Office.

Revision of the Regulatory Impact Assessment process

On 2nd April 2007, the Government announced a new Impact Assessment improving on the previous Regulatory Impact Assessment with a simpler, more transparent process that will be embedded in the earliest stage of policy making. The new arrangements were phased in from May 2007 are now fully operational¹.

Due to the timing of this Command Paper it is likely that it will contain Regulatory Impact Assessment rather than the revised Impact Assessments.
