### 1. Introduction

This document is designed to provide sponsors and their IT providers with the information required to design systems to create XML data files for upload into Bulk Data Transfer processes in the Sponsorship Management System (SMS).

This document lists the specific data format checks which are carried out by SMS during Bulk Data Transfer upload and migrant reporting operations. The format of the file required to facilitate BDT is XML Schema Definition (XSD).

This document does not contain all valid reference data values, as required in certain fields. For more information please refer to the 'Bulk Data Transfer - reference data valid from 1 October 2014' document.

**Please note**: the BDT schema has not been amended to require the English language and academic progression fields to be completed in order for files to upload. However, as these fields are mandatory in SMS, any CAS that do not contain this mandatory data will not be assignable until the information has been entered manually.

## 2. CAS Data Upload

#### 2.1 XML Validation

The XML file implements basic validation of the data upload, e.g. Mandatory Field, Basic enumeration.

### 2.2 Additional validation

The following table gives details of the field validation applied by SMS on upload of the data file.

All strings are trimmed of any white space before or after meaningful characters. If the string is empty after the white space is trimmed, that field will fail validation (if mandatory).

### 2.3 Detailed cross field validation

The following are the acceptable combinations of values in the English language qualification, Progression details and Work placement details sections of the CAS. Any other combinations will be marked with warning errors.

## 3. UK Postcode Regular Expression

The following is the UK Postcode Regular Expression and the corresponding detail explaining the logic behind the UK Postcode Regular Expression.

#### 3.1 Expression

#### 3.2 Logic

"GIR 0AA"

OR

One letter followed by either one or two numbers

OR

One letter followed by a second letter that must be one of ABCDEFGHJ KLMNOPQRSTUVWXY (i.e..not I) and then followed by either one or two numbers

OR

One letter followed by one number and then another letter

OR

A two part post code

where the first part must be

One letter followed by a second letter that must be one of ABCDEFGH JKLMNOPQRSTUVWXY (i.e..not I) and then followed by one number and optionally a further letter after that

**AND** 

The second part (separated by a space from the first part) must be One number followed by two letters.

A combination of upper and lower case characters is allowed.

**Note**: the length is determined by the regular expression and is between 2 and 8 characters.

## 4. CAS Migrant Reporting Additional Validation

#### 4.1 Validation

Below is the Migrant reporting additional validation detail:

- The Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) number must exist
- The Sponsor must own the CAS
- The CAS status must have a status of 'Used'
- The CAS activity history must be less than the configured value of 100 MAX\_ACTIVITY\_REPORTS\_FOR\_CAS \*\*
- A CAS cannot be reported against twice in the same upload file
- A CAS cannot be reported against, which has already been reported against on the same day (i.e. on the same date, rather than any 24 hour period)

<sup>\*\*</sup> When reporting activity against a migrant through Bulk Migrant Reporting, if any CAS record within the file already has 100 reports against it, this will cause the whole upload file to fail.

## 5. CAS Duplicates

#### 5.1 Introduction

Where the BDT upload identifies a duplicate CAS record it will warn the user but otherwise allow the operation to continue. The following conditions will generate a warning:

Within these conditions another CAS is defined as one of the following:

- · any other record in the bulk data upload file
- any existing pre-CAS
- any assigned CAS within the sponsor's SMS account

### 5.2 **Duplicate Conditions**

#### **EITHER**

This CAS record has APPLICATION ID defined

AND

This APPLICATION ID is an exact match of APPLICATION ID in another CAS

#### OR

• This CAS record does not have APPLICATION ID defined

#### **AND**

- The following fields match exactly their counterparts in another CAS:
  - o APPLICANT ID
  - CURRICULUM COURSE TITLE
  - COURSE START DATE
  - COURSE ID
