We have noticed that your recent Breeders Elite advert in Horse and Hound claims that you are 'Fully DEFRA (sic) and DARD approved'. As I am sure you are aware SIES – Studbook for Irish and European Sporthorses is approved by DARD but not by Defra. We also note that on the contact website address mentioned in your advert (www.breederselite.co.uk) that [REDACTED] area of work includes: "...making sure that the studbook runs in accordance with DEFRA (sic) legislation." SIES is regulated by DARD under The Horse Passports Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010, not Defra.

We require you to rectify these inaccuracies with immediate effect and publish a correction letter in their place as soon as is practicable. You must also ensure that no further communications of any kind include inaccuracies with relation to Defra.

We also understand that you have changed your name and contact details. If so can you confirm what your new contact details are.

Please confirm that this has been done by close of business Friday the 13th of September or we shall have to take further action.
