



## British Embassy Pyongyang

### CONSULAR INFORMATION

In an emergency (e.g. personal injury, road accident, arrest, plane-crash, civil disorder), time is often critical. Having personal information on visitors to the DPRK allows us to get hold of the right information quickly. If contact with the DPRK authorities is needed on official channels, it makes sure we have the right information. The only reason we hold this information is to help you.

#### WHAT CAN AN EMBASSY DO FOR ME?

- In an emergency we can help arrange medical treatment, medical evacuation (medi-vac), evacuation, emergency travel documentation and contact with your next of kin or national government. In cases of terrorism, civil disturbances or natural disasters we will make special arrangements.
- If you are arrested or detained we can request that you get proper treatment and fair representation, but we cannot simply get you out of prison.
- We cannot pay your medical bills. Medical bills can be expensive – a medi-vac from Pyongyang to Beijing costs approximately US\$25,000. You need to check you are insured. If we have your details we can help contact the insurance company to seek their authorisation of payment.
- We cannot interfere with another country's immigration policy or procedures. You should ensure you have a valid Chinese visa in your passport at all times.

#### BLOOD TYPES?

- In a medical emergency you might need a blood transfusion - blood testing facilities and a reliable local blood supply may not be available at the time. The UN Doctor therefore maintains a register of blood types within the local community. Having this information allows him to match possible donors in an emergency.

#### WHAT WILL YOU DO WITH MY PERSONAL INFORMATION?

- We will share your information with other resident EU Embassies as, depending on the scale of an emergency, we will have a coordinated EU response.
- We will share your blood type with the UN Doctor.
- We will store your information securely and only disclose it to third-country authorities if required in an emergency.

#### HOW DO I INFORM THE BRITISH EMBASSY?

- Complete the attached form and return it with a copy of your passport data page to the British Embassy. One form per person - partners and dependants should complete separate forms.

#### HOW DO I CONTACT YOU IN AN EMERGENCY?

- Embassy gate: on the right hand side of the German / British / Swedish Compound there is a telephone that links direct to the apartments of UK staff and a Duty Officer list indicating who to call.

**WHAT ABOUT WHEN I LEAVE THE DPRK?**

- Please remember to tell us when you intend to leave the DPRK permanently - our resources are limited and in an emergency we do not want to waste time looking for people who are no longer here. Help us to help those who need it.
