The MOD is consulting with people living and working around Salisbury Plain on its plans to accommodate troops returning from Germany.

As part of the Army Basing Programme, army units are being relocated to the Salisbury Plain Training Area. The Ministry of Defence (MOD) is preparing a masterplan to inform the planning for these moves. The MOD has been working closely with Wiltshire Council since mid 2012 on preparing and planning for these moves.

The MOD invite your views on the initial proposals which set out potential changes across the area between Larkhill, Bulford, Tidworth and Ludgershall. Other MOD sites in Wiltshire will see less significant changes. The pattern of army training may also alter within the Salisbury Plain Training Area, although the level of activity is not expected to exceed recent levels.
