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When filled in, the application form is marked 'OFFICIAL SENSITIVE' in accordance with the Government Security Classifications (see www.gov.uk). The unauthorised disclosure of the information it contains could facilitate the commission of serious crime – in particular by terrorists. It is for use only by those people within your organisation who need reasonable access to it, to ensure compliance with the conditions of the permit, and trusted contacts who advise you – such as your Radiation Protection Adviser/Radioactive Waste Adviser.

- Do not copy it to other parties without consulting the Environment Agency.
- Lock it in a secure cabinet or container when it is not in use.
- Make those who access it aware of the marking and the need to protect the information from unauthorised disclosure and loss.
- If you move it around, use a sealed envelope and do not mark the envelope 'OFFICIAL SENSITIVE'.
- If you post it, use 'Royal Mail special delivery guaranteed'.
- You should safeguard electronic copies of the data against unauthorised access. You should not email it.

Waste sources which are HASS or of similar potential hazard are no longer exempt from the need for permits while being accumulated. In order to ensure that HASS and similar sources have permits when they become waste, we will permit them for accumulation at the same time as we permit them for use. Category 5 sources are exempt from the need for permits for accumulation subject to the exemption conditions.
