Ensure transition plans are in place for individual Regional Development Agencies	All eight RDA transition plans have been received by the RDA Transition Board for challenge and iteration and will have been reviewed by the Board by December 2010. These plans will then be in place for RDAs to work from and update as required.
Agree form and content of electronic statements from credit card companies for consumers	Research received by UK Cards into credit card statements raised issues with ensuring that the electronic statements reflect consumer requirements. BIS is now working closely with UK Cards on this and aims to agree the form and content of the statements by January 2011.

Our immediate priority is to finalise the guidance as soon as possible, so that Departments responsible for new regulations can put it into practice. We expect that the guidance will be formally published in January 2011.</p>
