

- 1 Make sure your vehicle doors are locked, stay in your cab and secure the parking brake.
- 2 If you're in contact with your operating centre, tell them your location and the reason you've been stopped.
- 3 Show the other side of this card to the officer and ask them for ID.
- 4 Dial 999 and tell the police what dangerous load you're carrying, your location, and the officer's ID. The officer will also contact the police control room to tell them that they've stopped you.
- 5 If it's a legitimate stop, follow the officer's instructions.

Follow these steps if you're suspicious about the identity of the police or DVSA officer who has stopped you:

# DANGEROUS LOAD CARD
