COMBAT SHOTGUN L128A1 ON BARRACK RANGES

BACKGROUND

1. Following informal trials it has been demonstrated that combat shotgun practices using both slug and shot are suitable for use on all barrack ranges with both sand or granulated rubber bullet traps.

ADVICE

- 2. Following the LRWP meeting at Reference B, shotgun restrictions in Reference A Chapter 8 and 9 may be lifted.
- 3. Where a lot of slug ammunition is fired more frequent maintenance will be required to avoid the build up of lead in the bullet trap.

EFFECTIVE DATE

- 4. The required action is to be taken immediately on receipt of this notice.

DISPOSAL

5. This Range Safety Notice remains in force until the content has been incorporated into Reference A by a change or until it has been cancelled. In either of these eventualities, it can be destroyed.
