## **London 2014-2020 Q&A fact-sheet**

The London Enterprise Panel) is responsible for setting the strategic Growth priorities and direction of the London 2014-20 European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF), comprising a budget of €748.6m of European Social Fund) and European Regional Development Fund money. The Greater London Authority will have the role of an 'Intermediate Body', which means it will be undertaking some of the tasks the Government will be undertaking across the rest of England, such as issuing contracts, paying claims and monitoring.

A new Skills Gateway Service has been launched in Greater Manchester to provide small to medium sized employers with a single point to access a comprehensive catalogue of training provision and get support to find the most appropriate training for

their businesses. The Skills Gateway Service aims to promote the benefits that employers can gain from upskilling their staff. It is run by the Greater Manchester Chamber of Commerce and the Greater Manchester Learning Provider Network, with funds from the ESF and the Skills Funding Agency (Skills Support for the Workforce programme).

## The Skills Show Experience in Yorkshire and the Humber

Since September last year, colleges & providers in Yorkshire and the Humber have organised Skills Show Experience events in Doncaster, Leeds, Hull, Grimsby and Bradford. Feedback from the events has been very good. Highlights include a customised HGV trailer equipped with a 3D virtual reality centre where visitors (mainly comprising young people 14-24) had the opportunity to dismantle a virtual jet engine, and an outside area dedicated to

animal care and equine studies. More Skills Show Experience events in the area are to take place in Scunthorpe (14 October) and Bradford (3 December).

## Oldham Warehouse to Wheels scheme

A new Warehouse to Wheels scheme in Oldham is aiming to help lower skilled warehouse workers get higher paid jobs as Large Goods Vehicle (LGV) drivers. Including co-financed ESF support, Oldham Council and the Skills Funding Agency have invested a combined £200,000 to address the shortage of lorry drivers in the borough. As part of the council's Get Oldham Working programme, Mantra Learning Limited will train warehouse and other staff within small and medium enterprise companies (SMEs) to obtain Category C Large Goods Vehicle licences.
