If you answered 'yes' to either or both of the questions below you will need to provide a health report from your doctor (GP or equivalent) in the UK or EEA:

- 1. Have you consulted a doctor, or received professional medical advice or treatment in the last 10 years, for any mental health related problem such as those listed below?
 - suicidal thoughts or self-harm
 - depression
 - mania, bipolar disorder or a psychotic illness
 - · a personality disorder
 - any other mental health condition which you would consider to be relevant
