Secretary of State's determination of quarterly solar photovoltaic deployment

In accordance with Article 36 and Schedule 2 of The Feed-in Tariffs Order 2012 (hereafter, "the Order"), the Secretary of State has determined that the deployment of solar photovoltaic (PV) installations for the solar deployment period 01/10/2014 to 31/12/2014 was as follows:

Installations with declared net capacity of:	Aggregate capacity deployed in period (kW)
>0 - ≤10kW	123,688
>10 - ≤50kW	38,172
>50kW and stand- alone	52,774

For installations with a declared net capacity of 50kW or less, the data in the table above comprise the aggregate declared net capacity of relevant installations which, in the period above, were registered on the MCS database.

For installations with a declared net capacity greater than 50kW, the data in the table above comprise the aggregate total installed capacity of relevant installations which, in the period above, were determined by the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (Ofgem) to be entitled to accreditation, or were granted preliminary accreditation by Ofgem.

This determination is based on the 'MCS and ROOFiT Pipeline Statistics' table published by the Department on a monthly basis, and available at <u>https://www.gov.uk/government/statistical-data-sets/monthly-mcs-and-roofit-statistics</u>.

This deployment data will be used by Ofgem under Article 16 of the Order to determine the FIT payment rates for solar PV installations with tariff dates in the solar tariff period of 1st April 2015 and 30th June 2015, in accordance with Annex 3 to Schedule A to Standard Licence Condition 33.
