

Construction to Start on Site

Perry Barr and Witton Flood Risk Management Scheme

The first phase of construction of the new flood risk management scheme for Perry Barr and Witton will commence at the end of July 2015 and run until summer 2016.

Why are we doing these works?


Once completed the Perry Barr and Witton Flood Risk Management Scheme will protect over 1400 properties from flooding, such as the 2007 floods.

What are the works consisting of?

This phase of the works involves demolition of the existing brick wall and the installation of a new higher wall. Additional works around this include the construction of a small wall in the Atlas Industrial Estate, construction of a new community viewing platform, and installation of new flood gates across the bridge which gives access to the Atlas Industrial Estate.

How will this affect you?

Brookvale Road will remain open for the duration



of the construction period however traffic management is going to be employed to ensure that the work is carried out as quickly and safely as possible. This will involve a one lane closure which will move south as the works progress. Access to the Atlas Industrial Estate from Brookvale Road may be limited at times however you will still be able to reach the estate via Nobel Way and Holford Road.

What is next?

Once the works on Brookvale Road are underway we will post another update with information on the next phase of the construction works at Tame Road.
