Can you please send me contact details of the individual within the organisation responsible for this contract? Can you please send me two contact one from the fleet management (or equivalent) and the other procurement or purchasing preferably the category manager.</li><li>7. If the contract above was awarded within the last six months could you please provide me with the suppliers that were shortlisted?</li><li>8. I understand that the FOI Act is for recorded information but if you could be so help please include notes into what the organisation tends to do for future procurements. Extending contract, going to tender etc.</li></ol>
