Summary of discussion

Subjects discussed were progress with planning applications, changes to the planning system, community benefit, meetings with Somerset local authorities, waste and decommissioning financing, EDF's response to the Weightman report, EU processes and lessons learnt from nuclear power station construction in other countries.

Hergen Haye outlined the propriety rules which would guide DECC Ministers and officials now that EDF's application for development consent at Hinkley Point had been submitted. Under the Localism Bill the final decision on the application would be taken by DECC Ministers. Therefore, in summary, although Ministers and officials will continue to meet with applicant companies to discuss wider policy issues and, so far as is proper, to facilitate progress on aspects of individual projects, they will not enter into any discussion of the merits of an application.
