

In 2014 All Motor Vehicle traffic in Great Britain was


311 billion vehicle miles

2.4% increase from 2013


1.0% below the 2007 peak

Vehicles: 244.4 billion vehicle miles travelled by car (78.6% of traffic)

Light Goods Vehicle (LGV) traffic has grown, Heavy Goods Vehicle (HGV) traffic has fallen since 2004





LGV traffic in 2014 was the highest ever, for the second year in a row



Roads: Traffic on motorways in 2014 reached an all time high of 64.3 billion vehicle miles

Since 2004, traffic flows along roads managed by Highways England have increased by 5%



Context: Over the last 20 years there has been a decline in the rate of traffic growth

Car traffic per head was at its highest in 2002, and has increased in 2014 compared to 2013
