FREEDOM OF INFORMATION

Thank you for your e-mail to the Scotland Office of 5 October 2012.

You asked for the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000:

- Please provide a list of individuals who receive a salary from your department which is paid directly to a company, rather than their personal bank account. NB this should include cases where only part of the salary is paid to a company.
- For each person, please provide their name, their job/position, the amount they are paid annually, and the name of the company which the money is paid to. This should cover (at a minimum) all salary payments which have been paid in the last 12 months.
- If for DPA reasons it is not possible to provide the names of the individuals or of the companies, please nevertheless provide as much of the rest of the information as possible.
- I would be grateful if you could send the information via email. If there are a significant number of people on the list it would be useful if the information was supplied in Excel spreadsheet format - if it is only a handful then any other standard format will be fine.

The Scotland Office does not pay any staff salaries or any part of any salary directly to a company, rather than a personal bank account.

I hope you find this helpful.
