Consultation on changes to the Insolvency Service Enforcement Outcomes publication

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to the consultation on the proposed changes to the Insolvency Service Enforcement Outcomes publication.

1. Which statistics do you currently use?

The director disqualifications statistics are the most valuable, and, to a lesser degree the bankruptcy restriction/debt relief restriction orders. We have little or no use for the information concerning winding-up orders in the public interest nor of the suspension of discharge orders data.

2. Would the proposed changes to the frequency and timeliness of statistics meet your needs?

We would welcome the information on disqualifications and bankruptcy restriction/debt relief restriction orders being published monthly, however, we find information concerning the allegations to be extremely helpful in making presentations, and would therefore find it regrettable if that information were to be available only on an annual basis.

3. Would the proposed removal of statistics on SODs and allegations affect you?

The SOD statistics are not ones that we use regularly and would not be affected by their removal.

As stated above, the removal of the allegations would be a retrograde step.
