## COST

The projected annual pay bill for the full year ahead is £7.9 million. This includes the cost of employer pension contributions and National Insurance costs.

The estimated pay bill for the period 14th July 2016 – 31st March 2017 is £4.9 million

Special advisers represent an estimated 0.07 per cent of the Civil Service pay bill.

There are now 83 special advisers working across the whole of government - the total Civil Service has 420,000 civil servants
