1. Individualised Learner Record R05 for 2014 to 2015: Opens 16 December

Action

The Individualised Learner Record (ILR) R05 collection for the funding year 2014 to 2015 opens on **Tuesday, 16 December** and closes at 6.00pm on **Wednesday, 7 January 2015**.

Colleges and training organisations due to make a return for R05 must submit data to [the Hub](#).

(NOTE: The [Service Desk](#) will close at 1.00pm on **Wednesday, 24 December** and will reopen at 8.30am on **Monday, 5 January 2015**.)

2. Apprenticeship Grant for Employers: New Learning Delivery Monitoring Codes

Action

Colleges and training organisations that submit Apprenticeship Grant for Employers (AGE) claims for apprentices starting from 1 January 2015 must use the following Learning Delivery Monitoring (LDM) codes:

- **333** AGE Provider Payment Trigger
- **334** AGE Strategic Partners

These replace the existing LDM codes 132 and 133, which you can only use for starts up to 31 December 2014.

3. London European Social Fund Apprenticeship Grant for Employers for 16- to 24-year-olds

Information

The Agency has been working in partnership with the London Enterprise Panel to support apprenticeships' employer engagement in London.

From January 2015, employers with a London borough postcode employing up to 249 staff fulfilling standard Apprenticeship Grant for Employers (AGE) eligibility criteria may be entitled to £3,000 for eligible learners who begin Agency-funded apprenticeships.

This funding is co-financed by the European Social Fund (ESF) and therefore will require compliance with ESF funding rules.

5. **Community Learning and Mental Health Information**

In the 2014 Autumn Statement, the Chancellor announced a **commitment of £20 million** over two years, for courses to help adults in England with mild to moderate mental illness, such as depression, anxiety and sleep disorders.

We are working with the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills on the distribution arrangements, with £5 million available for the financial year 2015 to 2016.

We will invite proposals from directly funded Community Learning training organisations that work with local mental health partners.

6. **Apprenticeship Reforms: New Apprenticeship Standards Information**

On Tuesday, 9 December, 22 new, employer-designed apprenticeships were published, in professions ranging from data analysis to civil engineering and health and social care.

Over 1,000 employers, large and small, are now part of the Trailblazers' scheme designing employer-led, top-quality apprenticeships.
