18 The Data Protection Act 1998

The Environment Agency is responsible for improvements in navigation and the registration of boats on waters for which we have responsibility. We will process the information you provide so that we can deal with your application for boat registration, make sure you keep to the conditions of the registration, and process renewals.

We may also process or release the information to:

- offer you documents or services relating to boat safety, navigation and environmental matters;
- consult the public, public organisations and other organisations (for example, the Health and Safety Executive, local authorities, the emergency services, the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs) on boat safety, navigation and environmental issues;

- carry out research and development work on environmental issues;
- prevent anyone from breaking environmental law, investigate cases where environmental law may have been broken, and take any action that is needed;
- assess whether customers are satisfied with our service and to improve our service; and
- respond to requests for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (if the Data Protection Act 1998 allows).

Explanatory notes

1 Vessel details

If your vessel has previously been registered with us, please include the vessel registration number as this will speed up your application.

It is a registration requirement that every vessel must display the vessel's registration number. This must be displayed on the transom end of both sides of the vessel at all times.

Tariff class: Refer to the separate Anglian Waterways registration charges document to find the tariff class.

2 Registered

Only **one** person or organisation may be registered as the owner.

3 Dimensions

Please enter length and beam measurements in metres and tenths. 'Length' is overall hull length excluding moveable items such as rudder or outboard engine. 'Beam' is measured at the widest part of the hull.

13 Change of ownership

If you sell your vessel, it is your responsibility to notify us of the change of ownership in writing. You must complete the change of ownership form available from www.gov.uk/register-a-boat.

Until you do so, you remain the legal owner of the vessel and are therefore responsible for it. This means you are still responsible for registering it and paying any charges due.

14 Boat safety – construction and equipment standards

You must make sure your powered vessel complies with our construction and equipment standards at all times it is kept, let for hire or used on the Anglian waterways.

Boat Safety Scheme (BSS)

We may refuse to issue a registration or suspend a current registration if we find a vessel does not comply with these standards at any time.

All vessels carrying fuel or fitted with domestic cooking, heating, refrigerating or lighting appliances must have Boat Safety Scheme (BSS) certification with the exception of vessels covered by a Recreational Craft Directive (RCD) Declaration of Conformity* and privately owned open vessels with an outboard engine**.

BSS certification and RCD Declarations of Conformity are valid for a maximum of four years from the date of issue but all vessel owners are responsible for making sure their vessel complies with safety standards at all times.

Valid BSS certification details must be declared on this application form, except for privately owned outboard engine open boats (see definition below).

*Recreational Craft Directive (RCD)

We will accept a valid RCD Declaration of Conformity made by the vessel's builder instead of BSS certification for the first four years from new. This is because CE marked craft conforming to the Essential Requirements of the RCD will also comply with the construction and equipment safety standards of the Boat Safety Scheme.

**Privately owned open vessels with an outboard engine – definition

Boat safety scheme certification is not required for this type of boat providing it is not carrying or fitted with domestic cooking, heating, refrigerating or lighting appliances, other permanent electrical systems and it is propelled solely by an outboard engine without a fixed fuel system. This type of vessel must still comply with the relevant BSS requirements of the BSS Examination Checking Procedures for Privately Owned and Managed Vessels Parts 3, 4, 5 and 6 as appropriate. We strongly recommend fire extinguishers are also carried.

Note: A vessel which has any form of enclosed accommodation or which is decked-over the greater part of the hull is not regarded as an open vessel for the purposes of these requirements.

15 Insurance

You must have in force an insurance policy for the vessel, provided by a company that is authorised and regulated by the UK Financial Services Authority, which covers third-party liabilities of at least one million pounds. We do not need a copy of the insurance certificate but we carry out sample checks on declarations.

16 Tender discount

If your main boat is registered, a 50% discount applies to the tender. We define a tender as a small boat or dinghy, towed or carried by another boat.

17 Payment

All vessels are registered in accordance with The Environment Agency (Inland Waterways) Order 2010.

The full registration charge is payable for a vessel kept, used or let for hire on the Anglian Waterways at any time during the registration year (1 April to 31 March) unless it qualifies for the end of season discount (see below).

When registering the vessel, you are responsible to pay the full registration charge (see www.gov.uk/register-a-boat or call for our Anglian Waterways registration charges).

If you sell the vessel or it leaves our waterways, you may qualify for a refund. Refunds are only made in certain limited cases (see www.gov.uk/register-a-boat or call for our refund guidance).

If you sell the vessel or it leaves our waterways and are paying by Direct Debit, there may still be an outstanding balance. If you cancel your Direct Debit before the final instalment is paid, we may invoice you for the outstanding balance.

Calculating total discount

If more than one discount applies, the value of each one is calculated on the declining net balance.

For example, if the full charge is £100 and the boat is eligible for the electric and late registration discounts, the net payable would be £100 – 25% = £75 – 50% = £37.50.

Electric engine discount

Vessels with an electric engine receive a 25% discount on the appropriate registration charge, provided the sole method of propulsion is an electric engine/s and no other propulsion or charging engine is carried.

End of season discount

A 50% discount on the appropriate registration charge is available from 1 September.

This applies to a vessel that has not been kept, used or let for hire on one of our Anglian Waterways before 1 September in the registration year (1 April to 31 March). It also applies if the applicant is the new owner of the vessel.

Cam Conservancy waters

Powered vessels based on Environment Agency waters downstream of Bottisham Lock that wish to access Cam Conservancy waters must pay an extra 3% premium of the Environment Agency tariff.

Navigation key

Vessels navigating our rivers need a navigation key, available from us or one of our agents. These keys will be required to operate locks and/or provide access to facilities such as slipways.

River Advice for Boaters (RAB)

We encourage all river users to sign up to receive our free 'River Advice for Boaters' messaging service, which is currently available on the Rivers Ancholme, Nene and Great Ouse. We will call your mobile and/or your landline via an automated service which can send voice messages at any time. Once signed up for the voice message service, we can also issue text messages and emails.
