# Democratic People's Republic of Korea (North Korea)

### Introduction

 Council Regulation (EC) 329/2007 ("the Regulation") imposing financial sanctions against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (North Korea) has been amended to include additional prohibitions.

### **Notice summary**

- 2. The following is a summary of the additional financial sanctions measures:
  - With effect from 1 March 2017 it is prohibited to open a new bank account held or controlled by a North Korean diplomatic mission, consular post or their North Korean members
  - II. By 11 April 2017 any existing bank account held or controlled by a North Korean diplomatic mission, consular post or their North Korean members must be closed
  - III. Derogations may be authorised (if requested) for one bank account per mission, post and member

### Legislative details

- 3. On 28 February 2017 Council Regulation (EU) No 2017/330 ("the Amending Regulation") was published in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L 50, 28.2.2017, p.1) by the Council of the European Union.
- 4. The Amending Regulation amended the Regulation with effect from 1 March 2017.
