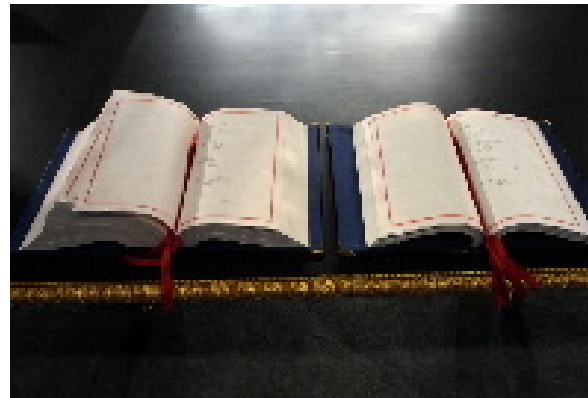

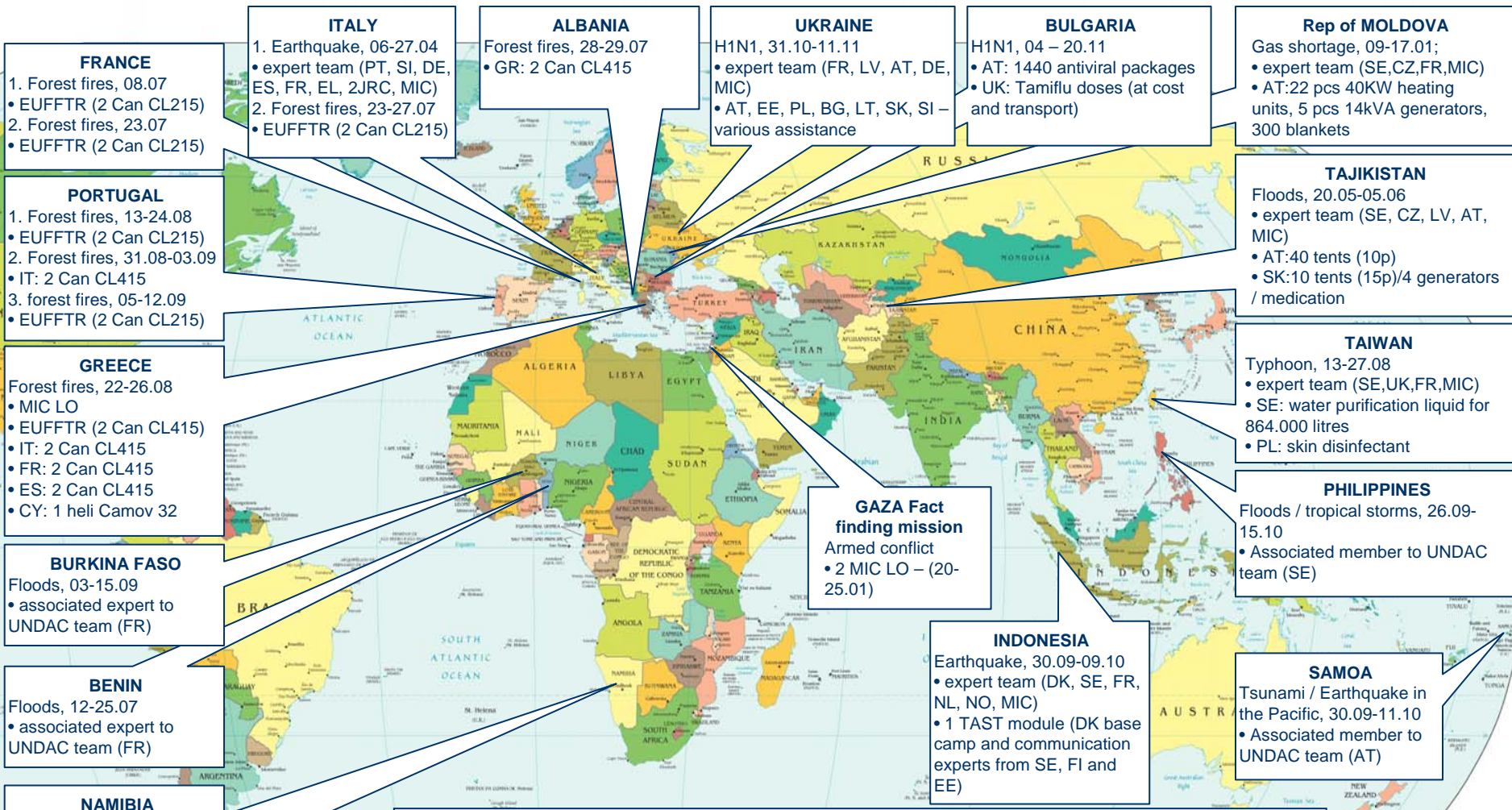
Scope

To **facilitate reinforced cooperation** between the Community and the Member States in Civil protection assistance intervention

Elements and actions

Preparedness (training, projects, workshops, exercises, early warning tools, MIC, CECIS)

Response (assessment and coordination teams, requesting Member State responsibility, Presidency responsibility, MIC, UN-OCHA)



Pre-alert was issued in the following emergencies: OPT/GAZA – armed conflict (19.01), UK – snowfall (06.02), SPAIN – forest fires (22.07);

Monitoring status was issued for FRANCE – storm (23.01) and BULGARIA – earthquake (05.08);

Other Mechanism activations (requests for assistance not followed due to situation improvements): FIJI - floods (16.01), TOGO floods (23.07), GUINEA - neutralization of toxic chemicals (03.08), ALBANIA – forest fires (13.08) and (11.09), GEORGIA – earthquake (10.09), 5 experts selected, mission cancelled as request was withdrawn.

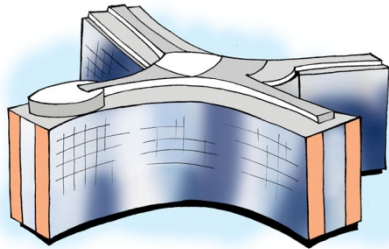

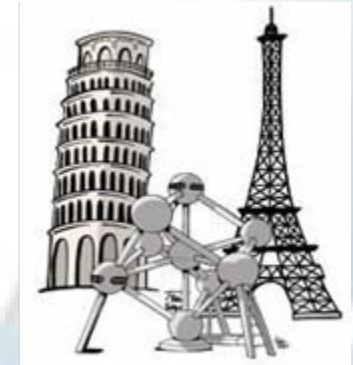
