Revocation of an Avian Influenza Prevention Zone

1. The Secretary of State has carried out a further risk assessment under article 6(1) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (England) (No 2) Order 2006¹ (“the Order”) and declares that the Avian Influenza Prevention Zone that was made on 12 May and has applied since 00.01 on 15 May 2017, and was planned to lapse at 00.01 on 14 June 2017, is hereby formally revoked in accordance with article 4(1)(e) of the Order at 00.01 on 14 June.
2. The parts of Lancashire, Cumbria and Merseyside where the Avian Influenza Prevention Zone is no longer to apply:
 - Barrow-in-Furness District
 - Blackpool Unitary Authority
 - Chorley District
 - Fylde District
 - Lancaster District
 - Preston District
 - Sefton District Metropolitan District
 - South Lakeland District
 - South Ribble District
 - West Lancashire District
 - Wyre District
