Thank you for your email of 28 March requesting the following information:

For 2016 (which is the 8th year of service for a soldier who joined the Army on a VEng(Short) in 2008):

- How many RA LCpls were considered for CONDITIONAL selection from a VEng(Short) to a VEng(Full) in 2016?
- Of those considered, how many were granted a CONDITIONAL selection to a VEng(Full) in 2016?
- What was the medical grading of those who were successful?
- Was medical grading alone a reason for non-conversion?
- If so, what was the medical grading of those who did not convert?
- What was the CEG of each of the successful candidates?

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

The answer to your enquiry is NIL. LCpls (known as LBdrs in RA) could be considered on a case by case basis but this has not yet happened.
