The balance of entries has changed, reflecting differences in content and demand of both tiers

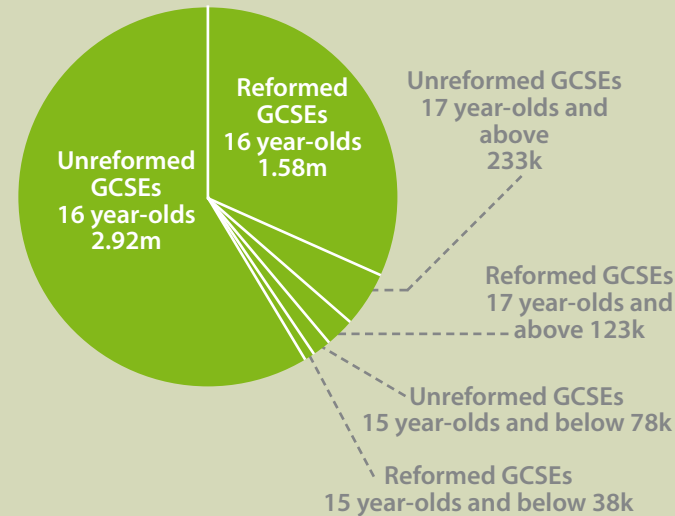

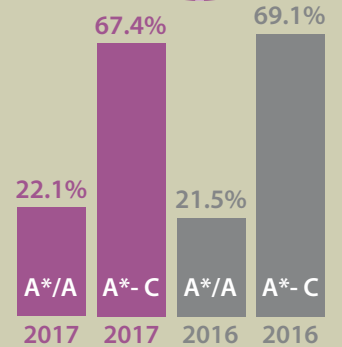
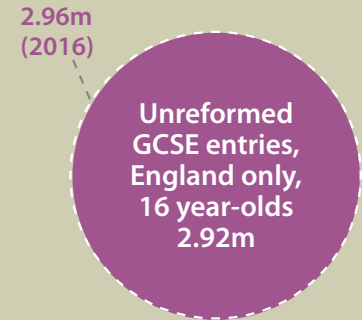
# GCSEs All entries, England

Breakdown by age and reform status



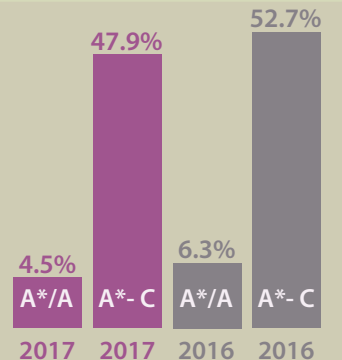
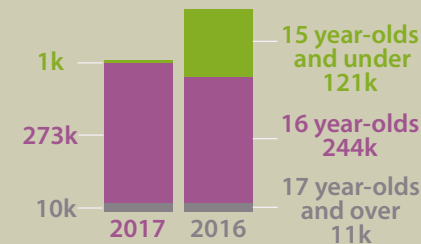
# GCSEs Unreformed
