




Young People and Health at Work

In 2019, UK employment rates for young people (aged 16–24)



In the UK,

8%

of people aged 16–24 in employment are on a zero-hours contract



compared to **2.7%** of all people,

and younger workers in temporary jobs are

29% more likely

to experience mental health problems



than those in permanent jobs

In the UK,



10.9%

of young people aged 16–24

were not in education, employment or training
