

Case Study 11: CCTV

Lincoln City Council has an extensive CCTV system in the City Centre which operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. There have been occasions where fly-posters have been recorded and an enforcement officer sent to the location. Not only does CCTV act as a deterrent but it can also be used as a method for monitoring perpetrators and facilitating prosecution. In Lincoln it is now the main method of enforcement used by the planning officers.

Cambridge City Council also combine the use of CCTV with liaison with DVLA to trace vehicles used by people fly-posting. Through sending warning letters, the City Council has successfully had posters removed without needing to take proceedings further.
