Objective:

To incorporate lessons identified by the Regulated Community throughout the 2018 Display Season to further align with civilian Flying Display Regulations contained in Civil Air Publication (CAP) 403 Edition 16 published on 28 January 2018 and reduce the complexity of interpretation by both Flying Display Directors and Display Flying Participants.

Amendments:

• Display Area definition to include detail on military and civilian height restrictions.

• Display Item definition included for clarity.

• Introduction of the term 'Secondary Spectators' and 'CAA Flying Display Permission' to cater for the Article 86 Permission and Private Flying Display Permission in CAP 403 Edition 16.



Amendments to Flying Display Director and Flying Control Committee responsibilities.

• Introduction of 'Too Low' and 'Too Close' Standard Warning Call descriptions and further detail provided on the potential use of the Terminate Call by Flying Display Participants.

• Clarification on the Flying Display Director accreditation process to include; validity and currency requirements, explanation of the military and civilian accreditation criteria and the introduction of both Deputy and Shadow Flying Display Directors and the upgrade process.

Guidance on arrivals and departure restrictions at Flying Display venues.

- Guidance on the approval and validation requirements for foreign military Air Systems.
- Revised weather minima for Flying Displays with the inclusion of minima for 'flat displays.'
