



Authorized Amendment

Due to evolving Defence requirements for RPAS, MAA Regulation has been subject to a number of incremental changes, which collectively have introduced unintended complexity and ambiguity. Equally, the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) are considering the implications of changes to European Regulation for Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS). There is therefore a requirement to both simplify existing RPAS regulation and to consider how best to keep pace with international best practice in this area.

Work will be undertaken in a 2-stage approach as follows:

a. Phase 1 - Changes to simplify and clarify existing regulation (Publish: Nov 19).

b. Phase 2 – Changes to ensure continued alignment of MAA RPAS regulation with

developing CAA regulation in this area (Publish under a separate NPA and NAA: Jun 20).
